Excluded from eligibility are any current or past officers of the American Legion Riders, Chapter 130 or their relations as described above.

Current Educational Requirements:

To be eligible to be considered as a potential recipient of the American Legion Riders Chapter 130 2011 Scholarship, applicants should be under 25 years of age at the time this application is submitted and meet at least one of the following criteria:

- In their senior year of high school
- A recipient of a GED within 12 months of submission of this application
- Currently attending or entering an accredited college, university or technical training institute.

Dispensation of Scholarship Funds

Scholarship recipients will be eligible to receive their scholarships immediately upon graduation from high school or on the first day of classes at the accredited educational facility into which they are matriculating.
